Congratulations to Charles Warren for winning his first professional tournament at the BMW Charity Pro-Am at the Cliffs. Charles closed out the tournament Sunday in Traveler s Rest by firing a 68 to win by 4 shots. Charles tied the tournament record at 23 under par and captured \$94,500 for the win to boost him to 2nd on the Buy.com money list. Two more wins this year will give Charles an automatic boost to the PGA Tour. Go Charles!

Charles fired rounds of 70-65-64-68 on his way to victory. The 23 under par score is only 3 shots off the all-time Buy.com tournament record 26 under par. All aspects of Charles s game were in sync for the week. He hit 82 percent of the fairways, 83 percent of the greens, and hit an average of only 27.8 putts per round. With 25 birdies, an eagle and only 4 bogies, Charles s consistency was his mainstay throughout the tournament.

Charles played a nearly flawless round on Sunday, marred only by a three-putt on 10 and a cell phone interrupted bogie on 18. In front a large cheering crowd of golf fans, friends, family, and a throng of Clemson followers, Charles played his best golf since returning to the tour from shoulder surgery that sidelined him for most of last year.
